Introductory

4. The Vice-Chancellor extended a very warm welcome to all members of the Executive Council. The Vice-Chancellor also welcomed Prof. Mehraj-ud-din Mir who attended the meeting as a special invitee and thanked all the worthy members for sparing their valuable time to attend the 13th meeting of the Executive Council.

5. The Vice-Chancellor made a detailed power point presentation highlighting the academic, research, infrastructure and developmental initiatives undertaken by the University during the period. Highlights of the presentation are as under:

- a) **Schools:** The Vice Chancellor informed the house that out of 13 approved Schools, 08 are functional. Out of 82 approved Departments, 21 are functional.



He also informed that 02 Centres, 12 Research Programmes, 04 Integrated programmes, 02 B. Voc. Programmes, and 02 Certificate/Diploma courses are functional in the University.

b) Dr. Asgar Hassan Samoon asked the University to focus on such courses which will add value to the society and to provide job opportunities besides upliftment of rural and urban area of the state and country.

c) **Teaching / Non-Teaching positions:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the members that out of 158 sanctioned faculty positions, 112 No. have been appointed (regular, deputation, contractual and tenure basis). He apprised the house that interviews for 20 faculty positions (Professors / Associate Professors / Assistant Professors) were held from 6th-14th June, 2017 and recommendation of the Selection Committee are being put up to the Executive Council in this meeting for approval. The Vice Chancellor also apprised about the vacant non-teaching posts advertised and informed the house that written/skill test have been scheduled in the month of October, 2017 for various Group A, B and C non-teaching posts.

d) **Admissions:** The Vice-Chancellor informed that the admissions for the session 2017-18 have been concluded for Under Graduate and Post Graduate programs. This year Central University of Rajasthan was again the nodal agency for conducting **Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET 2017)**. The process for online application forms was started from 14th March, 2017 to 19th April, 2017. The entrance test was conducted through offline mode on 17th & 18th May, 2017 at three examinations centres at Jammu, Udhampur and Kathua. The Vice-Chancellor informed the members that for the current session 2017-18, a total number of 23500 (approx.) applications were received from pan India candidates which were a threefold increase since 2015-16. He also informed the house that the numbers of girl students (65%) outscore the boy students in the University.

e) **Library:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the members that the Central Library had been digitalised since 2015. The various Digital services available are as follows:

- i. E-Journals, print Journals, E-resources, etc.
- ii. Fully automated library with open source library automation software KOHA.



- iii. Computer lab with Wi-Fi,
- iv. Reprographic services;
- v. Member of DELNET and INFLIBNET.
- vi. Number of Books: 19,140
- vii. E-Books: 300
- viii. Print Journals: 100+
- ix. Theses and Dissertations: 900+
- x. E-Journals: 7,027

6. It was suggested that the provision to access the E-library by all the students of the area may be looked into.

7. **Student support facilities:** The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about University Support facilities, i.e. the sports facilities (indoor / outdoor games), 02 newly opened Gymnasiums (at TAB and Main Campus), Yoga Centre, Banks and ATM services, Wi-Fi enabled campuses, transportation services for students / scholars, separate hostel facilities for boys and girls, 02 language labs (English and French), etc. provided to students / scholars of the University.

8. **JRF / NET / SET:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house that the University enrolled a total of **65 JRF / NET / SET** qualified candidates in various Departments (29 in Educational Studies; 12 in TTM/HRM & OB; 07 in Economics; 10 in EVS; 03 in English; 01 in Mathematics; 01 MCNM; and 02 PPPA).

9. The members suggested that Central University of Jammu should follow the procedure to award quality Ph.D. and the Chairperson informed that the University is following the UGC guidelines to award Ph. D.

10. **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU):** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house that the University has signed 03 MoUs at International level; and 17 MoUs at National level which includes recent MoUs signed with Hangyang University, Seoul, Korea and Vishwakarma Skill University, Haryana. Prof. K.L. Chopra wanted to know about signing of No. of MoUs by the University and their usefulness by the Departments to garner resources, benefits, etc. The Vice-Chancellor, informed the house that being a new Central University, the objective is to strive for national as well as international links



at this stage. Further, Prof. K.L. Chopra advised to implement the MoUs in true spirit for the benefit of students and faculty.

11. **Industry-Academia Collaboration:** The Vice Chancellor informed the house about the Industry-Academia Collaboration of the University for periodical review of curricula, apprenticeship and placements with reputed organizations like, CII, AIMA, VLCC, HDFC, ITC, etc.

12. **Workshops / Conferences / Seminars / Lectures:** The Vice-Chancellor highlighted the details of conferences / workshops / seminars / meets / lectures held in the University and informed the house that most of the events are externally funded by various organisations/agencies (Rs.2366.934 Lakhs for Resource Mobilization for Academic Activities). Dr. Asgar Hassan Samoon appreciated the efforts of the Vice-Chancellor.

13. **Major and Minor projects:** The Vice Chancellor apprised the house about the major and minor projects undertaken by the faculty (**especially science streams**) and grants sanctioned by the UGC. The Vice-Chancellor also apprised the house that Department of Mathematics has been able to get FIST in less than one year and appreciated the efforts of the new faculty. Dr. Asgar Hassan Samoon appreciated the efforts of the faculty for this remarkable achievement.

14. **Friday Clubs:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house about Friday Clubs, where students make presentations on the topics and fields outside their curriculum. This helps the students to have sufficient knowledge & exposure. As most of the students are from rural areas, special emphasis is being laid on their language skills (English) to make them confident in the urban and corporate society.

15. **Promoting Research:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house about the financial rewards offered by the University to promote and encourage research among faculty, research scholars and students :

- i) Best Teacher Award – Rs.1,00,000/-
- ii) Best Innovative idea by University student - Rs.25,000/-
- iii) Best Innovative idea by female entrepreneur / student of the region - Rs. 25,000/-
- iv) Minor Research Project – Rs. 2,00,000/- (for each Department)
- v) Best Researcher award – Rs. 1,00,000/-



vi) Financial support for participation in National Conference of Rs. 10,000/- and International Conference Rs. 35,000/-.

16. The member suggested to increase the amount of Best Teacher Award. They further advised that Central University of Jammu should create a quality education along with other new Universities i.e. Central University of Kashmir, 2 Cluster Universities. The Chairperson appraised about the vision and mission of Central University of Jammu including Planning Board constitution and its meeting on 28.09.2017.

17. **Fellowship / Visiting Fellow:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house about the achievements of faculty for fellowship, details as follows:

- a) Two faculty of Department of Environmental Sciences have been selected for prestigious fellowship, (i) Dr. Anita Singh, for Raman Fellowship (2016); and (ii) Dr. Shweta Yadav for Fulbright-Kalam Climate Fellowship (October, 2016)
- b) One faculty of Department of Computer Sciences & IT, Mr. Narinder Kumar, has been selected for Hungarian Fellowship (2015)
- c) One faculty of Department of National Security Studies, Dr. J. Jeganathan, was awarded Visiting Fellow to Fudan University China, 2016

18. **Kendriya Vidyalaya:** The members were delighted to know about the sanction of Kendriya Vidyalaya by the MHRD to Central University of Jammu in 2016. The Kendriya Vidyalaya was inaugurated by Sh. N. N. Vohra, Hon'ble Governor of J&K State, and Chancellor of the University on 26th April, 2017. The admissions for the academic session 2017-18 for classes 1st to 5th were undertaken in the months of June & July 2017 and the classes has been started.

19. **Incubation and Innovation:** The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house about the achievements of the University Incubation Centre (UIC). UIC has started Innovation lecture series, first lecture of the series was held on 20th January, 2017 and 08 incubates have been identified for incubation support. Members enquired about the field of innovations of candidates. The Vice Chancellor appraised that Incubation and Innovation Cell was established in last year and the projects are still under progress. Further, Dr. Asgar Hassan Samoon informed that Govt. of J&K has agreed to provide some funds for Incubation Centre of Central University of Jammu.



20. **NAAC Visit:** The Chairperson informed the house that the 1st visit of Peer Team of NAAC shall be held during 21st to 23rd September, 2017 and the University is fully prepared for the NAAC visit.

21. **Digital Initiatives:** The Vice-Chancellor informed the house about the initiation of digitalisation to the University by adopting various digital initiatives, such as; *Biometric Attendance, File Tracking System, Official e-mail id for employees, Intranet server set-up, Student Smart Cards, etc.*

22. **Outreach activities** The Vice-Chancellor highlighted various outreach activities, the main activities are as follows:

- a) General Orientation Course conducted for 185 newly appointed Asst. Prof in Higher Education Department, Govt. of J&K during Jan and Mar, 2017.
- b) Community College conducted the Training Programme for the Officers of Department of Horticulture Marketing and Planning, Jammu, Govt. of J&K during 18th-19th March 2017.
- c) Community College conducted placement drive for students of various disciplines i.e. Computer Electronics, IT Engg. of Colleges of BGSBU, IUST, UOK, JU , MIET in collaboration with industry Partner Planet Ganges. 20 students shortlisted after online assessment during February 2017 drive.
- d) Campus Employability Programme has been initiated by Community College in collaboration with NASSCOM Foundation, New Delhi in Jan 2017, for final year students.
- e) Yoga Centre conducted Yoga Classes for Civil Society, Students and Faculty in May, 2017.

23. **Convocation:** The Chairperson informed the house that 1st Convocation of the University shall be held in 3rd week of March, 2018.

24. **Academic Audit:** The Chairperson appraise the house about the visit of UGC-nominated Academic Audit Team visit to Central University of Jammu. The Academic Audit Team visited the University during 24th to 26th July, 2017. The house discussed on the agenda of the Academic Audit Team. The Chairperson informed the house that formal report of Academic Audit Team has not been received from UGC till date. However, no serious objections / comments were raised by the audit experts except



tendering of works before April, 2015, which were over and above the sanctioned funds by the UGC.
