To peruse report about the developmental activities in the University since the last meeting of the Academic Council held on 26th August, 2017.

During the period under report, emphasis has been on strengthening the existing academic programmes. During the current year, the University has 35 programmes across different disciplines.

1.1 Examinations and Results

- (i) The Examinations for 2nd, 4th and 6th semesters for Post Graduate Courses pertaining to Academic Session 2016-17 were held in May 2017. The average pass percentage of the said examinations is as under:

Activities undertaken by Engineering wing from July- 2017 onwards

- 1) 11th Building Committee meeting held 27.07.2017 in which apart from other decisions, it was approved to give provisional Time Extension upto 31.10.2017 to M/s EPIL, who are the Project Management Consultants of CUJ in view of the fact that all the work contracts tendered by the PMC are still operational and not finalized yet.
- 2) 12th Building Committee meeting held on 13.11.2017 in which following major decisions were taken :- i) to give further provisional Time Extension to the PMC M/s EPIL upto 30.04.2018 in order to allow them to finalize the near completion works of Road Package and process the final bills of completed works of other packages. ii) the drawing of Boundary Wall was finalized iii) prioritization of the proposed works for year 2017-18 to 2020-21 under Priority-I & Priority-II. The new works falling under Priority-I and amounting to Rs. 337.05 Cr. were included in the Revised Cost Estimate submitted to UGC.
- 3) The University Guest House Building was taken over by the CUJ on 01.09.2017.
- 4) The case of proposed construction of Kendriya Vidyalaya School Building having total cost of Rs. 16.13 Cr. is being put up to UGC for examination by the Standing Committee in order to fulfill the mandatory requirement as the cost of work exceeds Rs. 75.00 lakhs.
- 5) The work of construction of School of Education under PMMMNMTT scheme involving total cost of Rs. 6.92 Cr. is being assigned to CPWD as Deposit Work.

To start a joint Master degree programme in Nano Sciences and Materials with Ecole Nationale Superieure de Chimie, de Biologie et de Physique (ENSCBP), University de Bordeaux 1, France.

In the proposed Master course, semester I and II (48 credits) will be taught at Department of Nano Sciences and Materials, Central University of Jammu and semester III and IV may be taught at Ecole Nationale Superieure de Chimie, de Biologie et de Physique (ENSCBP), University de Bordeaux 1, France.

The Ecole Nationale Superieure de Chimie, de Biologie et de Physique (ENSCBP), University de Bordeaux 1, France has given its consent to start joint Master degree program. They are offering three modular courses. The students depending upon their background can choose one of these sets for their degree programme.

They have also suggested an agreement under which the students will not pay tuition fee at Bordeaux but at the host University in India. The University of Bordeaux will also award them a Master degree based on their performance at ENSCBP Bordeaux. The University of Bordeaux will teach in English.

The same has also been approved by the Board of Studies of the concerned Department on 27.04.2017. The Minutes of BoS and module for Course/Syllabi is enclosed as *Annexure- IV, page no 42- 52*.

As per clause 7 of Ordinance 11 regarding Conditions of Service of Teachers appointed in the University (Gazette Notified), every teacher confirmed in the service of the University, shall continue in such service until he/she attains the age of superannuation as prescribed by the UGC and Govt. of India from time to time.

Further, Dr. Jitendra K. Tripathi, Joint Secretary, University Grants Commission has informed vide his letter no. F.No. 71-2/2017(CU) dated 12 May, 2017 to amend the respective Statues regarding enhancement of the age of superannuation of teachers from 62 to 65 years (Annexure V, Page no. 53).

Section 26 (d) of the Central Universities Act, 2009, *inter alia*, provides that the appointment of teachers, academic staff and other employees of the University, their emoluments and conditions of services shall be prescribed by the Statues 22 (1) to (4).

Accordingly, Statues 22 needs addition of another point for age of superannuation of teachers from 62 to 65 years in the said Statue.

A draft Statue in this regard is placed Annexure V, Page no. 53 for consideration of Academic Council.
